SAP Parking

Triangle Bins

No progress encountered on this yet

Parking Working Group

- Removed as standalone agenda item as cadence of meeting is without MS/VSM therefore no specific progress beyond as above per action log
- Original estimate from MS was implementation per 1st March, now unlikely

Residents Reported

- Estate wide general litter problems
 - o This has been acknowledged and a weekly litterpicking has been installed until at least the end of March
 - o Beyond March this may fall under the remit of a new EM role
- Bulky rubbish dumping in bin areas of apartment blocks
 - Bulky rubbish can easily be arranged for collection by Hillingdon Council any just dumped is fly tipping and should be reported
 - o Signage in bin areas suggested as stop gap solution & education examples are in Partridge Close
 - o This should be done through education & knowledge sharing and not an increase in service charges
 - Will be raised with MS during next meeting attendance to establish if estate-wide strategy can be implemented
- Issue with plot 128 and their neighbour dumping their rubbish on their property shall we ask Mainstay to write to all residents reinforcing where bins should be placed.
 - MS has done a circular to all households but this is opt in only can this perhaps be shared on the website post-minutes?

SAP in Bloom

- Representation met with MS contacts
- MS/VSM have agreed to input flower beds, likely in each phase
- Costing is being put together by Scotscape for this and being provided to VSM
- Looking to collaborate with local garden centres if there's a competition element, could they do vouchers, or a resident discount for SAP to help residents on their green arrangements?
- Looking to coincide this with Hillingdon in Bloom which is being held in July
